PUBLIC SPEAKING CLUB

Our Public Speaking club is designed to help members practice speaking, improve vocabulary and gain confidence in communication in a fun, and supportive environment. It is specifically designed to navigate the students in a right path in building confidence, Critical thinking, leadership qualities, Teamwork and overcoming fear. It is open to all English learners of 1st B.SC, BCA, B.COM.

Activities:

- 1. Panel Discussion Simulation:** Students are assigned roles as experts on a topic and must discuss the subject from assigned viewpoint in a panel format.
Goal: Simulates real time world professional discussions, fosters public speaking skills and develops the ability to defend a point of view.
- 2. Think-Pair-Share:** Pose a question to the group. First, students think about their response individually, then pair up to discuss their thoughts. Finally, they share their ideas with the larger group.
Goal: Encourages individual thinking followed by collaboration, making discussions more inclusive and well-considered.
- 3. Devil's Advocate Discussions:** Assign one or two students to argue against the prevailing opinions, regardless of their personal view. This forces others to defend their opinions more rigorously.
Goal: Strengthens argumentation, critical thinking and helps students examine their assumptions
- 4. Impromptu Speeches**
How it works: Participants draw a random topic and have 1-2 minutes to prepare a short speech.
Goal: Enhances quick thinking and ability to speak on various topics without preparation.
- 5. One to One Discussion**

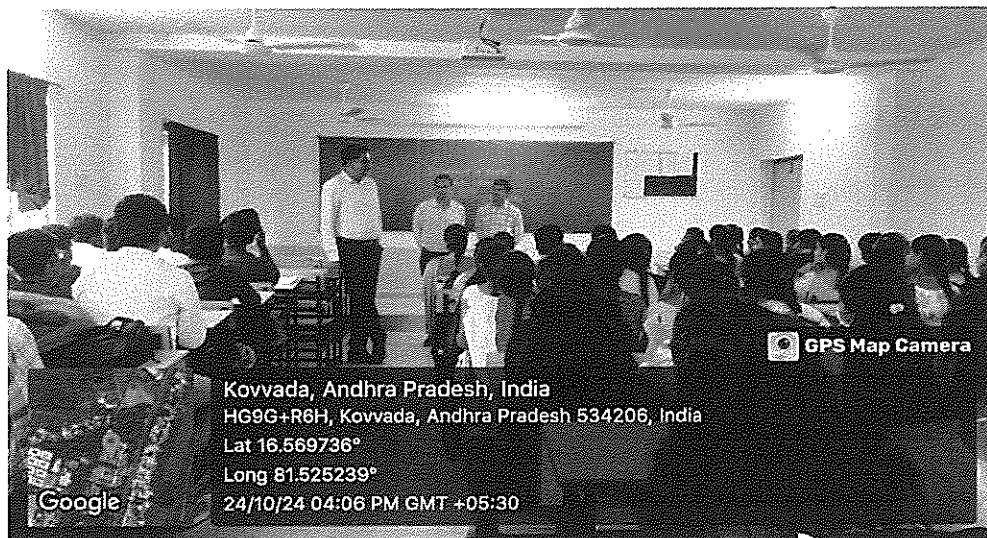

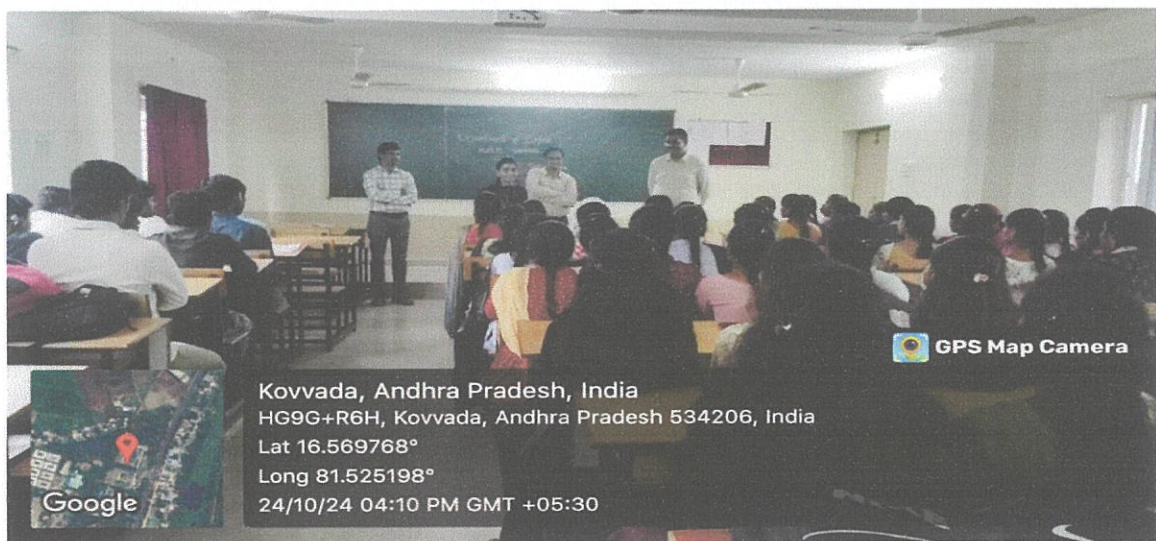
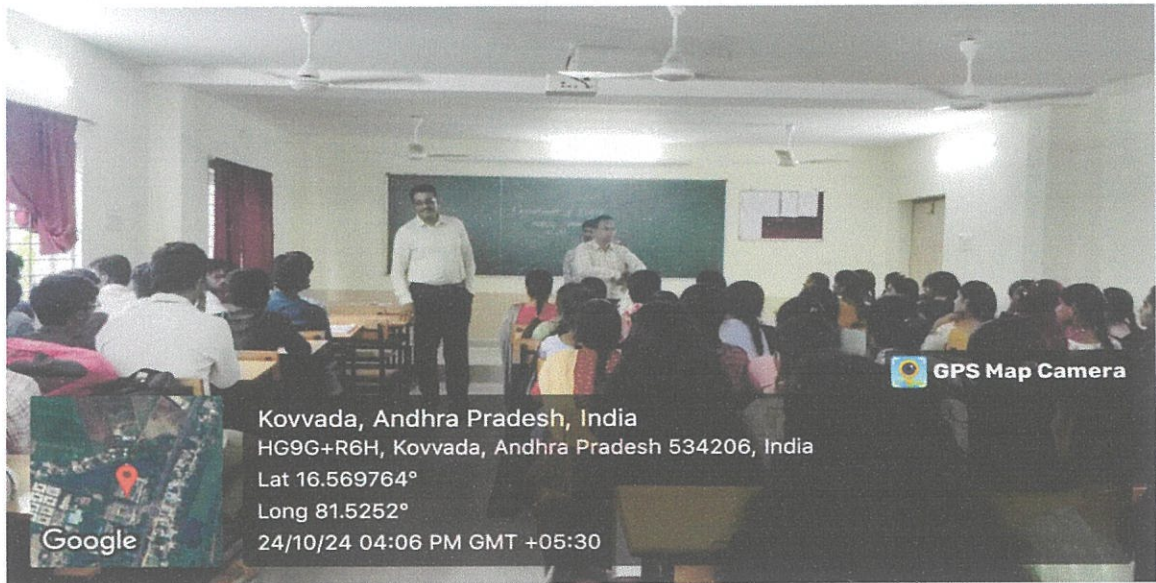
INAUGURATION

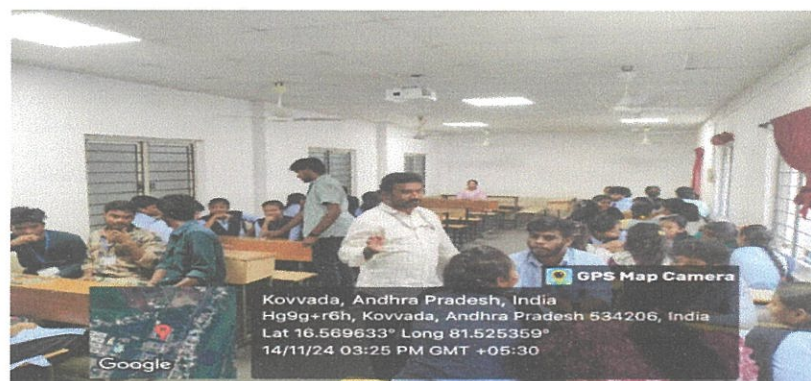


PUBLIC SPEAKING CLUB

Speaking in public freely means that they are able to express well everything what they wish to communicate with others. Developing public speaking helps one to develop all required skills for a successful career.

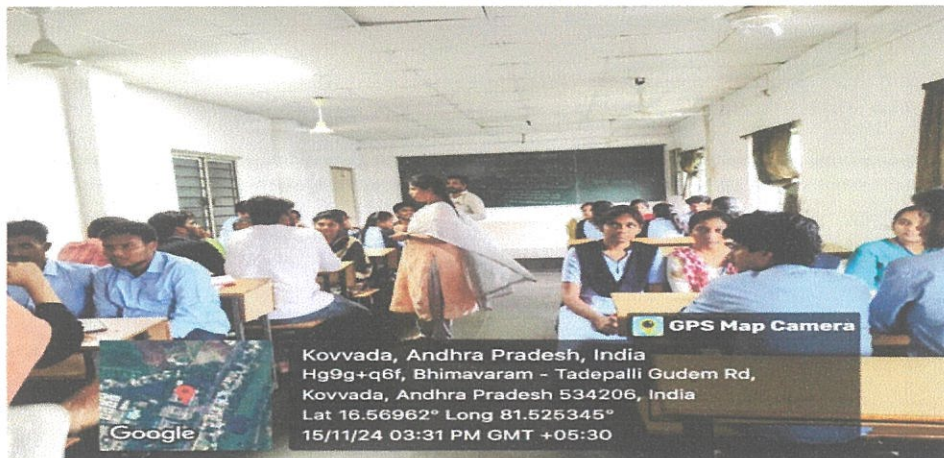
